## Solution for Companion Box

In order to open the box, find the circle which is able to rotate a little bit. Make sure that one is facing upward. Put the box on a flat surface and give it a good spin. The rotating force will make sure all the four pins will slide to the corners of the box. They won't block the rotating mechanism anymore. This will enable you to rotate the circle. Once you rotated the circle you'll be able to open the box and take the two parts apart. If you practice really well it is possible to replace the rotating part of the box by giving the box a small spin with your hand while holding it in the air. It will blow the mind of people watching you open it while they're not able to do it themselves.
